Rules for "Raise Your Level" Giveaway Contest

GENERAL INFORMATION: The sponsor of the "Raise Your Level" Giveaway Contest (the "Contest") is Avid Technology, Inc. ("Sponsor"), having a place of business located at Avid Technology Park, One Park West, Tewksbury, MA 01876 USA.

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN, AND NO OBLIGATION OF ANY KIND IS IMPLIED. THIS CONTEST IS VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW. PARTICIPATION CONSTITUTES ENTRANT'S FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL AGREEMENT TO AND ACCEPTANCE OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES. THIS IS A TRADE PROMOTION ONLY, AND THE CONTEST IS OPEN ONLY TO LEGAL RESIDENTS OF THE U.S., CANADA, UNITED KINGDOM, AND REPUBLIC OF IRELAND WHO ARE AGE 18 OR OVER AND WHO MEET THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS DETAILED IN THESE OFFICIAL RULES. The Contest begins on October 15, 2009 at 8 a.m. United States Eastern Time and ends on November 12, 2009 at 11:59 p.m. United States Eastern Time.

ELIGIBILITY: The Contest is offered to all natural persons age 18 and over as of the date of entry, who are legal residents of the United States (with the exception of the States of New York, Florida, and Rhode Island), United Kingdom, Republic of Ireland, and Canada (with the exception of the Province of Quebec). Employees, independent contractors, officers, and directors of Sponsor, its affiliates, subsidiaries, distributors, advertising, promotion and fulfillment agencies, and the immediate family members and persons living in the same household of such persons are not eligible to participate in the Contest.

Submit the completed form via e-mail by clicking on "Submit Entry." Completed entries must be received by 11:59 p.m. United States Eastern Time on November 12, 2009.

Entries submitted via the internet will be deemed made by the authorized account holder of the e-mail address submitted at the time of entry. In the event of a dispute, each potential winner may be required to provide proof that the potential winner is the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with the potentially winning entry. The total number of eligible entries received determines odds of winning.

THE PRIZE: One (1) person randomly drawn from the total population of those who submit a correctly completed entry form will receive one (1) Pro Tools|HD 3 Accel system and (1) 192 I/O Pro Tools|HD audio interface. The Pro Tools|HD 3 and 192 I/O have a USMSRP of approximately seventeen thousand nine hundred and ninety dollars (\$17,990.00), a euro retail price of approximately twelve thousand seven hundred thirty euro (€12,730), and a pound sterling retail price of approximately ten thousand eight hundred seventy pounds sterling (£10,870).
