

DigiRack X-Form Plug-in Read Me

This Read Me documents known issues and workarounds (when applicable) with the Digidesign X-Form plug-in.

Known Issues

Previewing with the Polyphonic Audio Type Does Not Sound as Expected

Because the Polyphonic setting is so demanding on system resources, when previewing in Polyphonic mode the Poly (Faster) algorithm is used for faster previewing. However, when you process the audio selection, the high-quality Polyphonic algorithm is used.

Changes to the Audio Type During Preview Don't Take Effect Until After Preview is Stopped (Item #80703)

During preview, changes to the Audio Type do not take effect until you stop and restart preview.

Previewing Extreme Settings at 4x and 8x May Result In Audio Drop Outs or May Appear Unresponsive (Items #80659, #80661, #80662)

Because of the system requirements for high-quality pitch shifting, and time compression and expansion, X-Form cannot process the material fast enough for real-time previewing at extreme settings on slower machines. However, non-real-time processing is applied at the highest quality.

With Longer Selections, Preview Doesn't Start Immediately (Item #80784)

With longer selections, preview may not start right away. This is because X-Form must analyze the audio prior to previewing it. Preview should start as soon as the analysis pass is completed.

Pro Tools Systems

AudioSuite Preview Is Unavailable (Item #77010)

With Pro Tools 7.0 and 7.1, AudioSuite Preview functionality is unavailable.

X-Form Is Not Available for TCE Trim Tool (Item #80208)

With Pro Tools 7.0 and 7.1, X-Form is not available for the TCE Trim tool.

Avid Systems

X-Form Appears As Unsupported in Avid Software (Item #77722)

X-Form has been qualified with the most current shipping Avid software products, including Xpress Pro and Media Station. However, the current shipping versions of Avid software erroneously report Digidesign X-Form as unsupported. (A tilde “~” appears before the plug-in name in the AudioSuite tool indicating that it is unsupported even though it has been qualified by Digidesign.)

Not All X-Form Features Are Fully Supported with Avid Software (Item #77725)

AudioSuite Preview and updating the time display fields (Bar|Beats and Feet+Frames timebase only) does not work properly with the currently shipping versions of Avid software.

Avid Software Cannot Adjust the Length of a Clip After Applying X-Form (Item #77728)

The process works correctly, as long as it fits within the boundaries of the clip that is being modified. If you want to increase the duration of the clip with X-Form, you must first increase the length of the clip by extending the clip boundaries.
