

# Transfuser 1.0.1 Plug-in

This Read Me documents known issues and workarounds with the Digidesign Transfuser Plug-in.

## Known Issues

### **Pro Tools Quits Unexpectedly the First Time You Insert Transfuser on a Track (Issue #101627)**

After installing Transfuser or manually deleting the DAE preferences, Pro Tools crashes after the first time Transfuser is inserted on a track. This occurs only if particular untested or unqualified third party plug-ins (such as Massey plug-ins) are also in the Plug-ins folder.

### **Pro Tools 8.0 HD Quits Unexpectedly when Trying to Relink Audio Files Manually (Issue #112136)**

If you try to relink a file that has been imported from a network or USB drive and that has not been copied to the session folder, Pro Tools quits unexpectedly. You should always copy files from transfer volumes during import to local playback volumes to avoid this problem.

### **Pro Tools Quits Unexpectedly when Adding a File to Transfuser and Then Removing It from the Project Browser (Issue #107710)**

If both Transfuser and Pro Tools are referencing two different audio files that have the same name, and you delete the audio file from the Region List that Pro Tools is referencing, Pro Tools quits unexpectedly.

### **Transfuser Transport Cannot Be Started Under Some Circumstances (Issue #112602)**

#### **(Pro Tools 8 Mac OS X on PowerPC Only)**

On Mac PowerPC machines running Pro Tools 8, after Transfuser has not played back for a while or when editing while Transfuser is stopped, the Transfuser transport may not start as expected. To correct this problem, re-insert Transfuser or drag to another insert.

### **When Using “Save Copy In” Command, Transfuser Does Not Link User Audio Files in the Session Copy (Issue #102852)**

#### **(Mac OS X Only)**

When opening a new session copy, Transfuser may indicate that audio files are not linked. The unlinked audio files must be manually relinked by creating a copy of the session located in a destination folder other than the original session’s parent folder.

#### **To avoid this problem when saving a session copy, do the following:**

- 1 Choose File > Save Copy In.
- 2 In the Save Copy In dialog, choose a destination other than the same parent session folder as the original session.
- 3 Ensure that the All Audio Files option is not selected.
- 4 Click Save.
- 5 Close the current session.

### **Overwriting an Existing Transfuser Track with the Same File from Another Folder Causes the File to Be Deleted from the Project Browser (Issue #104244)**

When keeping two identical copies of the same audio file in different locations and loading one of them into a Transfuser drum pad, it will be displayed in the Project browser. When this sample is replaced by the copy from the other location, the sample disappears from the Project browser instead of updating the Project browser entry with the new file path.

### **The Incorrect File Unique ID is Used in Some Cases During Find and Relink (Issue #107634)**

Manual Find and Relink using the unique file ID is not supported with Transfuser.

### **When Deleting or Removing a File from the Project Browser, the File Is Not Unloaded from Transfuser (Issue #104162)**

When deleting or removing a file from the Project browser, the file still loads in Transfuser but does not appear in the Project browser after saving, closing, and re-opening a session. The audio file no longer appears in the Project browser but still loads in Transfuser.-

### **When Dragging Files from the Region List or Workspace Browser, the Drum Sequencer and Slice Sequencer Editors Are Not Updated (Issue #104054)**

When dragging an audio file from the Region List or the Workspace browser to a Synth module, the Drum Sequencer and Slice Sequencer Editors are not updated to show the new audio file.

### **Cannot Drag and Drop SDII Files Directly from Windows Explorer or DigiBase Browsers to Transfuser (Issue #110100) (Windows Only)**

Drag and drop the SDII file to the Pro Tools Timeline first to convert them to the session file format (such as .wav). Then drag and drop the region from the Timeline or the Region List to the plug-in.

### **The Pencil Changes to Brush Tool Only After Mouse Is Moved or Clicked While Holding the Shift Key (Issue #102678)**

In the Slicer Sequencer Editor, the Pencil tool will change to the Brush tool only after the mouse is moved or clicked while holding the Shift key.

### **Play Button Flickers When Assigned to a Fader (Issue #104246)**

When the Play button is assigned to a MIDI fader, moving the fader causes the Play button to flicker.

### **Factory Tracks Folder Not Highlighted When Browsing to Previous Folder (Issue #103747)**

When browsing into a Factory Tracks folder and then returning to the previous folder level, the previous folder is not highlighted.

### **When Dragging Audio onto any Synth Module, the Destination Module Does Not Highlight (Issue #104438)**

When dragging audio from the Recorder, or Slicer or Phrase or Synth module editors to another Synth module, the destination synth module does not become highlighted.

### **Wrong Note Length Created on MIDI Track when Exporting MIDI from the Drum Sequencer to Pro Tools (Issue #109246)**

When exporting MIDI notes to a Pro Tools MIDI track, the note lengths are always extended to the end of the bar or the next note.

### **The Drum Pattern Editor Menu Buttons (Select, Edit) Highlight Randomly (Issue #104148) (Mac OS X Only)**

The Drum Pattern editor menu buttons (Select, Edit) highlight randomly after clicking.

**Pro Tools May Crash When Simplified-Chinese Characters Are Used in User Account Names or Settings File Names (Issue #102525)**

On simplified-Chinese systems, Pro Tools may crash if User account names or Settings file names contain simplified-Chinese characters.

**When Loading a Preset in the Edit and Master Section, Simplified-Chinese Characters Become Transparent (Issue #102530)**

After loading any file containing simplified-Chinese characters in the file name, characters in the file-dialog become difficult to read.

**Transfuser Plug-in Header Disappears when Opening or Closing the Browser or Editor Pane (Issue #111185)**

Close and re-open the Transfuser Plug-in window to correct this problem.

**Cosmetic Issue in Audio Import Menu (Issue #104254)**

After dragging an audio file into Transfuser, the boxes around the description and the OK and Cancel buttons are darker than the rest of the window when the Import menu appears.

**Cosmetic Issue While Scrolling (Issue #104049)**

**(Windows Only)**

When dragging a sample from a Drum Pad to another Transfuser Track such that downward scrolling occurs, when reaching the last track it is not possible to scroll up again. The destination module will also not be highlighted.

**Cosmetic Issue on M.A.R.I.O. Apply Button (Issue #102952)**

**(Windows Only)**

Graphic artifacts sometimes occur when the M.A.R.I.O. Apply button is clicked repeatedly.
